




FIRST-TIME EVENT!

SPECIAL GUEST LECTURER: Purdue Distinguished Professor RANDY ROBERTS



For the first time on a PC cruise, the President's Council welcomes guest lecturer Randy Roberts, Distinguished Professor of History in the Purdue College of Liberal Arts. An awardwinning educator, Professor Roberts' specializes in teaching military history (including courses on World War I and World War II), sports history, and popular culture.

He has won several national book awards and has been nominated for the Pulitzer Prize four times. His most recent book, co-authored with Johnny Smith, is Blood Brothers: The Fatal Friendship Between Muhammad Ali and Malcolm X. Professor Roberts has served frequently as a consultant and on-camera commentator for PBS, HBO, and the History Channel. Two of the documentaries in which he was featured won Emmy Awards.





Sunday, June 4 // 2017 Arrive Basel, Switzerland

Embark the S.S. Antoinette and join your fellow Boilermakers this evening for welcome aboard orientation and Captain's reception followed by a Purdue-themed gala dinner.



Monday, June 5 // 2017 Kaysersberg, Riquewihr & Colmar, France

Venture ashore for an Alsatian "Village Day" to the postcard-perfect Kaysersberg for a guided walking tour. Continue to medieval Riquewihr. You'll have free time for wine tasting and a chance to taste a regional specialty, flammekueche, a delectable flatbread topped with bacon and onions. After lunch, enjoy a walking tour of Colmar, what some call "one of the most beautiful villages in France."



Tuesday, June 6 // 2017 Strasbourg, France

Strasbourg boasts a UNESCO-designated city center with a magnificent Gothic cathedral and charming half-timbered houses. See the sights on a canal cruise and enjoy an optional history lesson with Professor Roberts through the picturesque Petite France district. This afternoon, enjoy additional time at leisure or journey through the lush countryside with lunch in a traditional farmhouse and a visit to a cuckoo clock workshop.



Wednesday, June 7 // 2017 Speyer, Germany

The medieval town of Speyer has a compact historic center boasting the largest Romanesque cathedral in Europe. Be sure to visit the Technik Museum with the largest, most impressive historical collection of planes, trains, automobiles, and more. In the afternoon, learn about unique wine vinegar aperitifs on an excursion to the Doktorenhof vinegar estate.



Thursday, June 8 // 2017 Rüdesheim, Germany Cruising the Romantic Rhine

Explore Rüdesheim and its famous Drosselgasse — a narrow lane lined with taverns and shops — before enjoying a wine tasting and a visit to the 14th-century Castle Vollrads. Return to the ship for a scenic cruise along the spectacular, UNESCO-protected Upper Middle Rhine. Our cruise along the 40-mile-long stretch is graced with sloping vineyards, picturesque towns, and hilltops crowned by fairytale castles.



Friday, June 9 // 2017 Boppard & Koblenz, Germany

After a morning of scenic cruising and a historical overview with Professor Roberts, head ashore. Discover the German Corner, where the waters of the Moselle meld with the Rhine, before taking the aerial tram ride up to Ehrenbreitstein Fortress. This mighty military structure has guarded the Rhine since the 11th century and offers dazzling views. After lunch, if you are adventurous, take a tour to Marksburg Castle. Ascend the Riders Stairs to visit the chapel tower, prison, and banquet hall, and get a sense of medieval life in a castle that was never destroyed.



Saturday, June 10 // 2017 Cologne, Germany

Weave through the narrow Old Town streets of Cologne en route to the city's imposing Gothic cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Inside this centuries-old pilgrimage site is a shrine believed to hold relics of the Magi — the Bible's fabled Three Kings. In the afternoon, relax onboard the ship on the Sun Deck or in the lounge enjoying afternoon tea as we cruise toward Amsterdam. Saturday evening, we'll enjoy the Captain's Farewell Reception and a Purdue-themed gala dinner.



Sunday, June 11 // 2017 Amsterdam, Netherlands

Disembark the ship and transfer to Amsterdam Schiphol Airport.
