



4-Night Denali Summit of North America Post-Cruise Package August 20–24, 2026

Please Note: This post-cruise package is hosted by Silversea Cruises and is not affiliated with the President's Council or Global Tracks.

Thursday, August 20, 2026 | Disembark in Seward / Girdwood

Enjoy a final breakfast onboard the Silver Moon. Debark and bid farewell to the Silversea ship as you board the exclusive **Grandview Cruise train** and enjoy the picturesque views of Alaska (approximately 3.5-to-4-hour ride). Guests will **disembark in Anchorage for some free time to explore the city** and stop for lunch (on own account.) Then, board your motor coach for your 45-minute journey to the **Alyeska Resort**. Following check-in, the balance of the day (including all meals) is at your leisure. There is time to take the Aerial Tram to the top of Mt. Alyeska for a superb panoramic view of the valley, however this will be at your own expense.

Overnight Alyeska Resort, Girdwood (B)

Friday, August 21, 2026 | Girdwood / Denali

After breakfast at the hotel, board the waiting transportation to depart on a **full-day scenic motor coach trip to Denali**. Stop en-route at **Martin Buser's home for an exclusive visit**, where the four-time Iditarod Champion will regale you with tales of the Last Great Race and the wonderful champion dogs he raises and trains for mushing. Martin became fascinated with sled dogs while still a teen. He came to Alaska in 1979 to enhance his knowledge of care and training of sled dogs. He began working and training with long-time Alaskan mushers Earl and Natalie Norris and ran his first Iditarod in 1980. A **boxed lunch** will be provided after the Kennel visit.

Arrive at Denali around 5:00 pm and check-in to the **Grande Denali Lodge**. Afterwards you may wish to take advantage of the extended sunlight and enjoy an evening stroll through town. Dinner tonight is on your own.

Overnight Grande Denali Lodge at Denali National Park (B,L)

Saturday, August 22, 2026 | Denali

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and join with other travelers from around the world on the **fully-guided Tundra Wilderness Tour**. Please be aware that these tours are offered in conjunction with local native Alaskans, and the only type of transportation permitted inside the National Park are often the same school busses that local children use in the rugged winter months. You will get an ongoing informational talk from your driver/guide, along with **wildlife spotting and spectacular scenery**.

Watch for **moose** between headquarters and Savage Campground and look for **caribou** anywhere above tree line. If you're lucky, **Mount Denali** may make its first appearance around Mile 9. As you ride over high mountain passes you'll want to keep an eye out for **Dall sheep or bears** on the mountainsides.

***** Optional Upgrade: \$450 per person**

Having seen the Park from the ground, take to the air for a thrilling 30 to 45-minute flightseeing excursion and a bird's-eye view of the Denali National Park. Flights are provided on a 5-6 passenger sightseeing plane so space is limited and will be offered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Speak with your travel professional to inquire about pricing and availability.

Return back to the hotel, the balance of the day is at your leisure. Enjoy dinner on your own this evening.

Overnight Grande Denali Lodge at Denali National Park (B)

Sunday, August 23, 2026 | Denali / Anchorage

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a **reception with a mountain climber speaker** to hear about ascending North America's tallest mountain.

Late morning, transfer to the rail depot board the **Deluxe Dome Railcar Service for the scenic ride to Talkeetna**. During your thrilling ride through the thick forests and along the edges of steep valleys, you may catch a glimpse of native wildlife from the comfort of your **glass-domed rail car**. Along the way cross **Hurricane Gulch**, perched more than 300 feet above the river below. Seating is under windows that extend 180 degrees around you, so you'll be able to thrill at the majesty of this and other sites along the way. There is even an open-air platform if you'd like to step outside and stretch your legs a bit.

Lunch will be served in the dining salon at mid-day. You will be amazed at the variety of items the chefs can prepare - from delicious hot and cold Alaskan specialties to authentic reindeer chili!

At Talkeetna disembark the train and take this opportunity to stretch your legs a bit. Board a motorcoach for the last leg of your journey to **Anchorage and the Downtown Marriott Hotel**. Dinner this evening is on your own.

Overnight Downtown Marriott Hotel, Anchorage (B,L)

Monday, August 24, 2026 | Depart Anchorage

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast this morning and some **additional time to explore the city**. Your Silversea representative will arrange your **transfer to Anchorage airport** for your homeward flight based on your flight time.

Important Notes:

Alaska offers 5-star scenery; the accommodations are somewhat less. The Grande Denali Lodge offers comfortable, but simple, rooms and is only open during the summer months; likewise, the Downtown Marriott operates at its peak capacity at this time of the year and is staffed with seasonal personnel. Lapses in service do occur. The Tundra Wilderness Tour included on Day 3 is an exclusive concession of local native Alaskan residents. In order to minimize the impact of visitors on the eco-system, this tour may consolidate the members of the Silversea group with other travelers.

Luggage Information:

You may bring your entire luggage with you during this trip. Provisions will be made to transport luggage if you would prefer to leave several of the largest pieces at the hotel in Anchorage.

Accessibility:

This tour is accessible to all guests; however, there may be sites where uneven ground makes certain locations unsuitable for wheelchairs.

Health:

Mosquitoes are at their worst during peak season - June, July, and August. If you plan on traveling into the backcountry or in wooded areas make sure to take bug spray along with long sleeved pants and shirts.

Minimum Participation:

All Land Programs require a minimum number of participants in order to operate as described. If this minimum number is not obtained, Silversea reserves the right to offer the program at a different rate based on private arrangements, or to cancel a specific departure.
